Today we celebrate Palm Sunday.

This morning, we celebrate the triumphal entry of Jesus as He enters the city of Jerusalem for the final week of His ministry. He is headed towards the cross, thousands have gathered, but few will remain. Today, pastor Dan will consider a third encounter in which Jesus asks someone, "What do you want?" And today, we see two blind men who wanted to see. As we consider the events of Palm Sunday, let us all ask the Lord for this same request. Let us all ask that we might see, not just the world around us, but rather the truth of the cross, who Jesus is, and what He is calling us to. While most of the people around Jesus thought they knew who He was, let us be counted amongst those who see and know that Jesus is the Son of God, the Saviour of the world.
