This morning, Jasse Saint Jean will talk about the Righteousness of God vs The Wickedness and Sinfulness of Men .

In the beginning of his epistle to the Romans, Paul wanted to remind his readers that as sinners, we are all lost and on our way to spend eternity in hell far from the presence of the Lord. But he did not stop there.

Otherwise he would only be a bearer of bad news. To help us follow the train of his thought, he used a very important term: "The righteousness of God." With the introduction of this new term, Paul wanted to demonstrate God's love and His plan to rescue humanity.

Today, we will analyze this righteousness. We will demonstrate that it was not created by man, but by God Himself. When we obtain it through "Redemption" in Jesus Christ, not only we are "Justified" by the blood of the Lamb, but all our debts have as well been paid in full.
