What does the Hand of God look like? The truth is, it can look like a lot of things. For Pharaoh it looked like plagues and destruction. For Moses it looked like salvation. For David it looked like a stone and a slingshot, and still for Elijah it looked like fire from heaven.

But what does it look like when God needs to correct us? When we've chosen disobedience over faithfulness, selfishness over sacrifice and our own desires over God's will.
