

Welcome to our Communion Service, Sunday, Mar. 1, 2026

The Bible says that God's ways are not our ways and God's thoughts are not our thoughts (Isa 55:8). This statement is both comforting and terrifying. It brings us comfort when life is confusing and we need reassurance that God is in control, and yet, it can be terrifying when we feel we know what's best and what should happen but God does the exact opposite. This is where we left our prophet Jonah last week; completely at odds with God

This week, we will see what can only be called an all-out fight between the prophet and the Sovereign God. The problem is, it's getting harder and harder to argue with Jonah, and yet, we must trust God. That's the big question Jonah leaves us with—is it ok to argue and fight with God and still say we trust Him? Can we question Him, be disappointed in Him, and yet still love Him with all our heart? This is where Jonah is leading us—lots of questions, very few answers.
