There are many strange stories in the Bible, but none so strange as the story of the prophet Jonah. A man unwilling to do God’s work, unhappy to preach a message of repentance and unrelenting in his miserable ways. This is Jonah, the man God used to save an entire city with 120,000 inhabitants. A man not so different than many of us!

Today, pastor Dan begins a 7 part preaching series on the book of Jonah, a book with just four chapters, and yet a book filled with insight into both God and us. As we study this book together, let us all consider how we can learn the lessons of Jonah, and discover a God who is not interested in our opinions, rather He is interested in saving the lost, redeeming the “unredeemable,” and using people in spite of themselves.

In Jonah we will find an unwilling prophet and an unrelenting God. Can you guess who wins?
